TROUBLES PERMANENT DISABLEMENT PAYMENT SCHEME ADVICE AND SUPPORT

Applicants to the Troubles Permanent Disablement Payment Scheme have today been reminded that help and advice on making an application to the scheme is available free of charge.

In a statement, Mr Justice McAlinden said:

"I recognise that the application process can seem both complicated and daunting. The Victims' Payments Board does not want that be an impediment to any one making an application to the scheme and so we have ensured that free advice and support is available to those who need it.

I would strongly encourage anyone who has suffered a permanent disablement as a result of a Troubles-related incident, and who requires assistance, to get in touch with one of the groups who are providing this free service to victims and survivors.

I have met the groups on a number of occasions and am fully assured of their commitment to providing the necessary support and assistance to applicants to this important scheme. "
